It doesn't matter how: **texting, having dinner**...if you're willing to do that, better to break up with your boyfriend before." PHILIPPINES "It starts with emotional intimacy with others." UK "Anything that betrays trust in a relationship. There is debate about emotional cheating—more and more people flirt online or send pictures or content that might be deemed inappropriate by their partner.
